Internship

All bachelor degree students are required to complete a Summer program at Coventry University in year two, which will be transferred to Narxoz University as Educational Internship. In addition, students are required to complete a Kazakhstan Internship while at Narxoz University in Kazakhstan in year three and an International internship while at Coventry University in year four. Internships give students the opportunity to gain real world global business experience and the chance to apply the knowledge they acquire during their course work.



Senior Capstone

In their fourth year at Coventry University, all students are required to complete and pass a Diploma Project and an online defense in front of a state attestation committee of Narxoz University, as required by the Ministry of Education. Students will be co-supervised by Coventry and Narxoz faculty members throughout the process.

Senior students have several options to put the skills they have acquired to the test:

1. Consulting project for startup or tech enterprise
2. Research thesis supervised by experienced mentors at Narxoz and Coventry
3. Case study or creative startup project
